Any application that is INCOMPLETE, or includs supporting documents that have not been translated, or are illegible and/or do not correspond to what is required will be rejected.

- All documents must be translated into French or English
- Proof of family resources must show the identity of the person concerned and the ANNUAL TAXABLE amount of income received in 2023, or in 2024 in the event of a change of situation.
- PDF format is required, or JPEG for images (photos, scans)



#### ACCESS TO THE CAMPAIGN.

The link of FSA application is only provided by the registrar's office of your department. You have to contact them directly.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- $\Rightarrow$  During the campaign you can :
  - Fill in the application form
  - Attach the requested documents
  - Modify incomplete application
  - Modify the complete but not submitted application
  - Submit the application <u>After submission you will not be able to modify your application</u> <u>anymore</u>



The FSA application allows you to fill in the application *in several times.* 

PLEAS REMEMBER TO SAVE after each modification by clicking on :

⇒ When all the fields of the application form are filled in, the file is considered **COMPLETE** 

It can then be **SUBMITTED**.
