

PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

What is a Public Liability Insurance ?

A Public Liability Insurance covers any individual for damage caused to others.
(e.g.: breaking of a computer during an internship, harm/damage during a visit to a plant, and so on...).

It must not be confused with Social Security affiliation (refund of medical expenses), Complementary Health Cover and Lease Public Liability.

At Grenoble Institute of Technology, this insurance is compulsory for all students
(including students during their study year abroad).

For your information, if you can't justify this type of insurance, it is possible, at the time of registration, to take out an insurance policy from one of the student mutual companies (LMDE, SMERRA).
